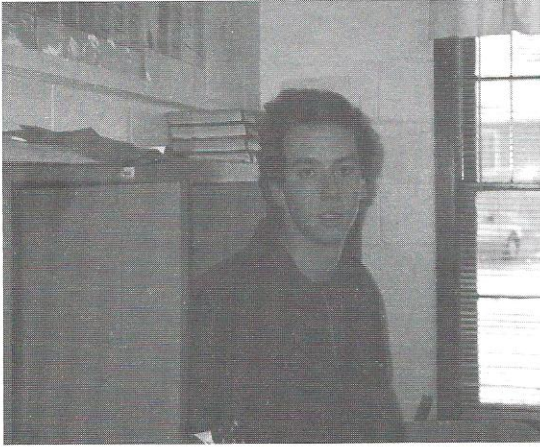


Radio

Jaime smiles after a long day of cheering and clapping in the stands at USC Salk.

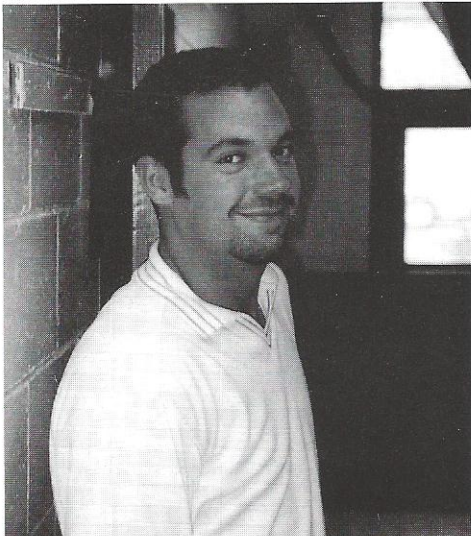
