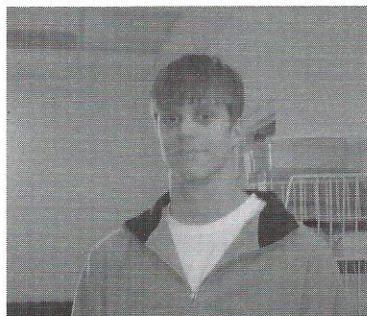

Q. ARE THESE REALLY "THE BEST YEARS OF OUR LIVES?"

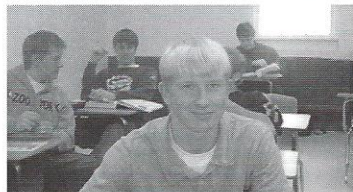

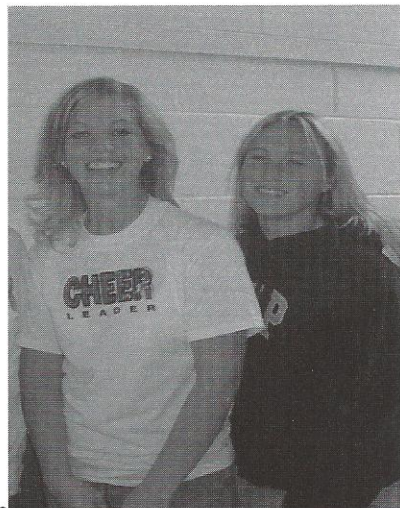
