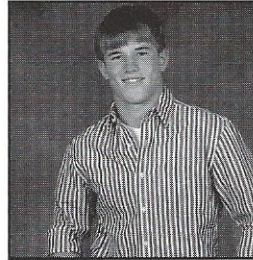
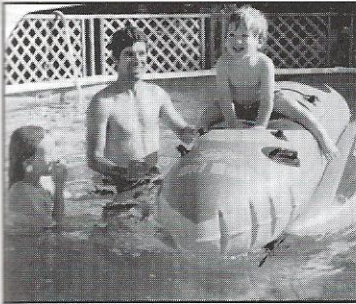


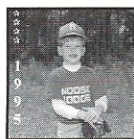
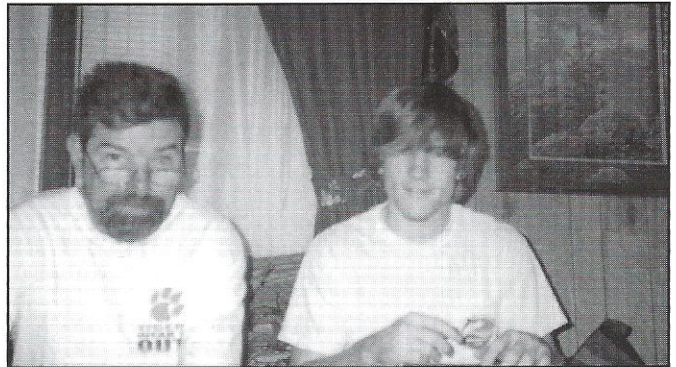
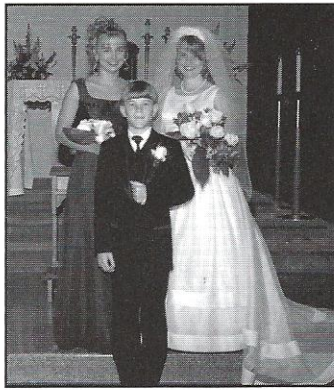
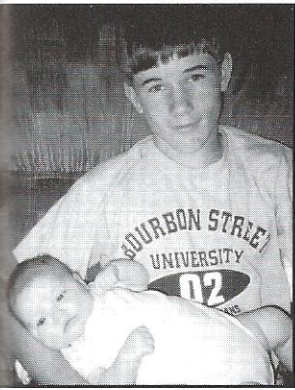
Gus White
