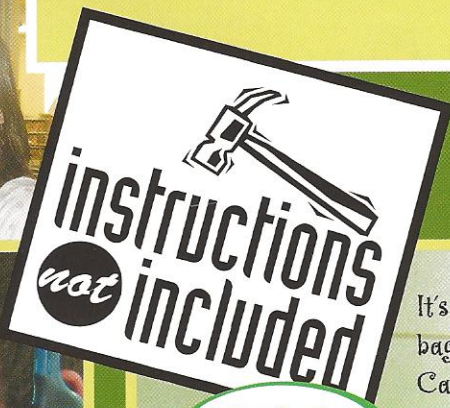
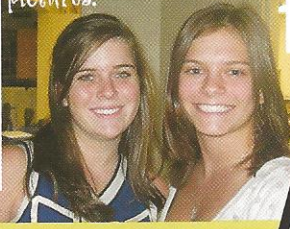

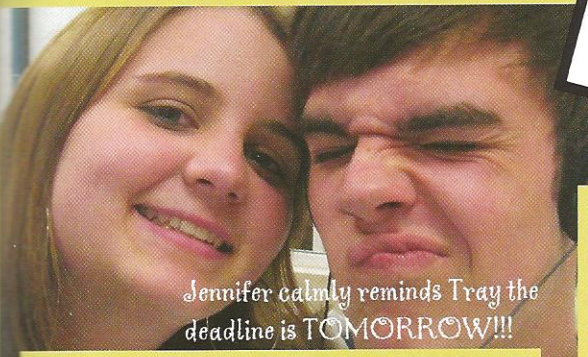

Joslyn tells Ellie she's scanned over 300 pictures.

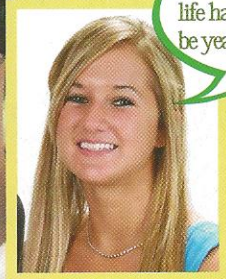

We vow to work hard on the yearbook and accept the advice Mrs. Brown gives us.

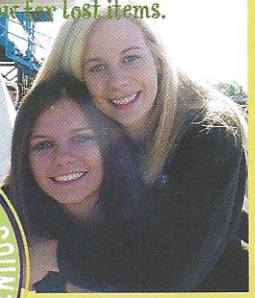


Jonathan scans last year's book for ideas for his sports section.
