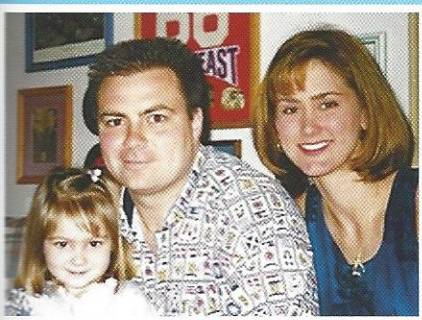
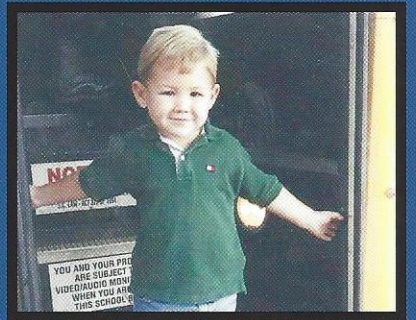
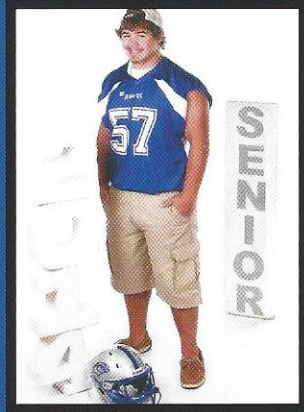
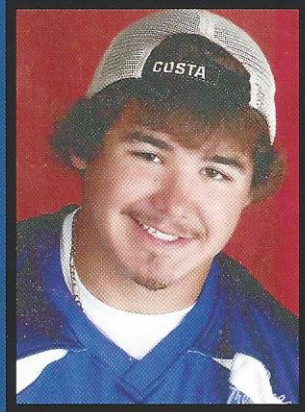
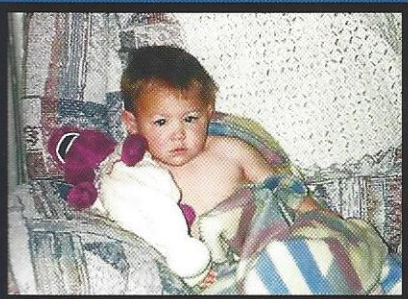
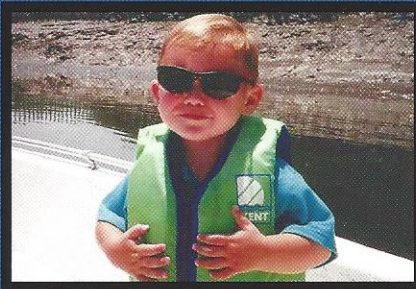


Cody Blanton Beach
