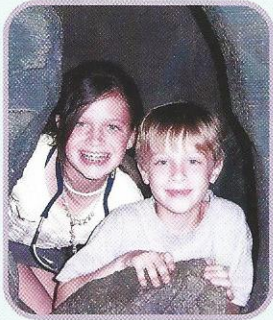


Cameron Elizabeth Schrimpf

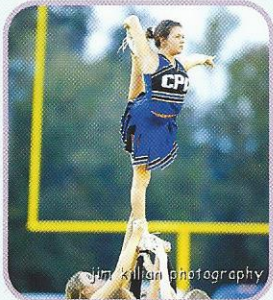


Cameron,
