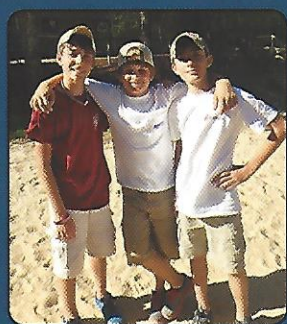


Middle School Academics
