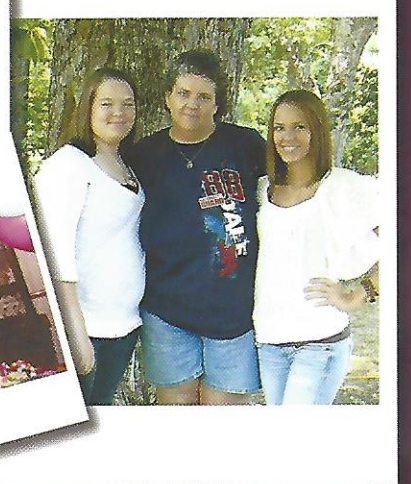
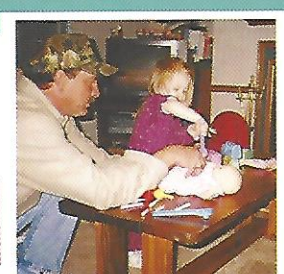
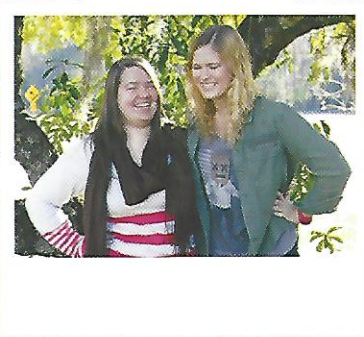
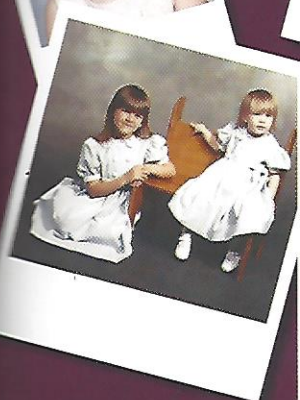
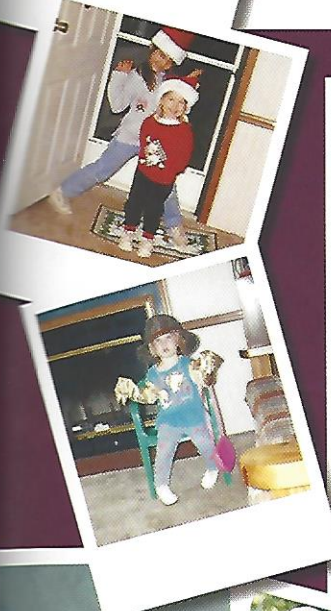


Samantha Ada Murdaugh
