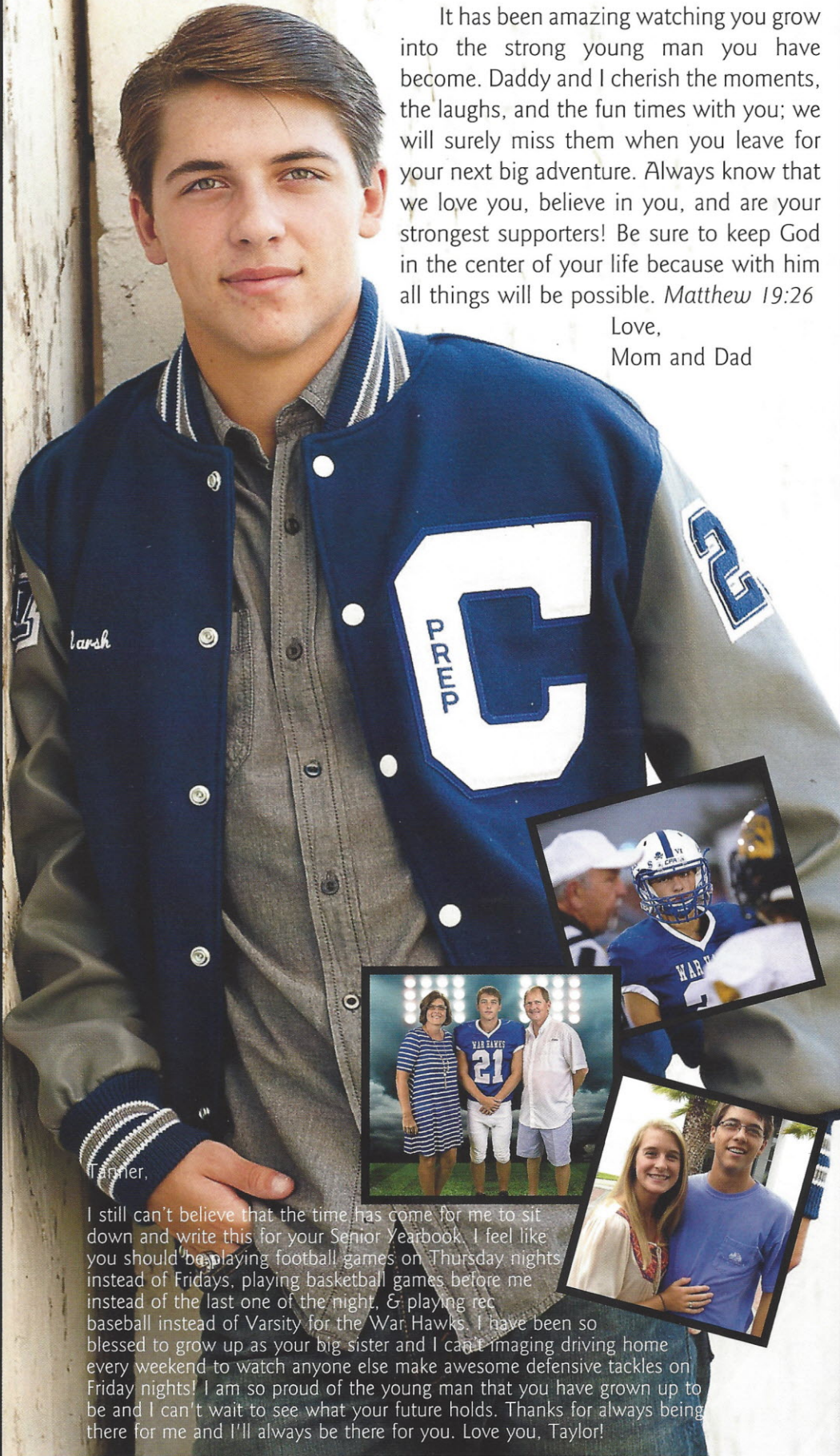
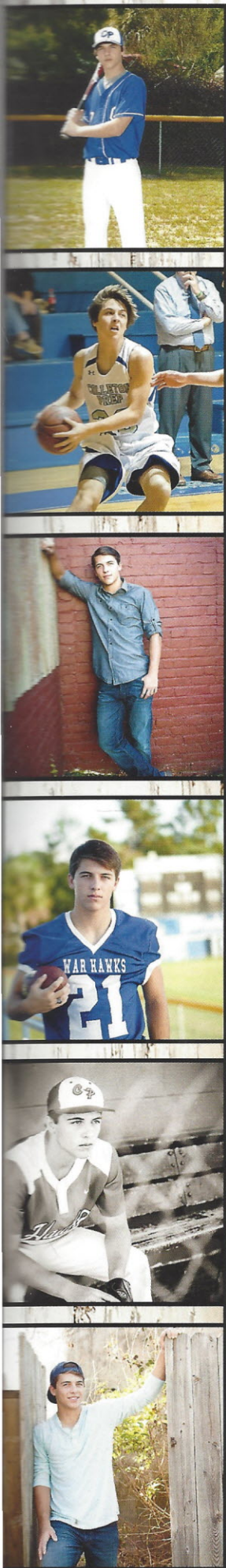


# TANNER CLINT MARSH
