Secret Pal Day is one of the most awaited Colleton Prep traditions! It is always exciting to see how the older students choose to reveal themselves to their little pals.

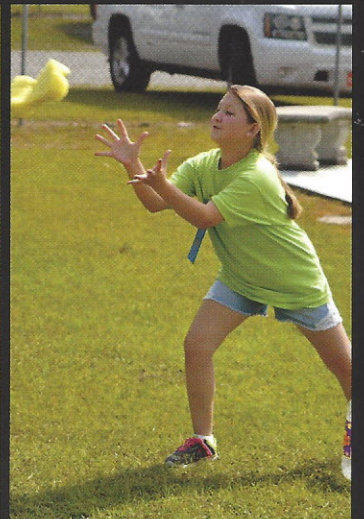

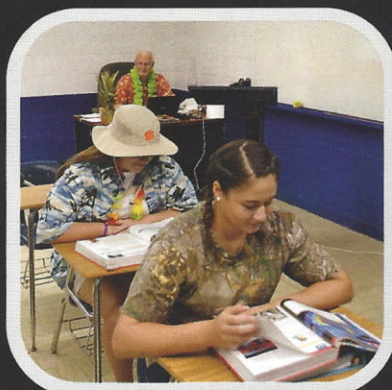

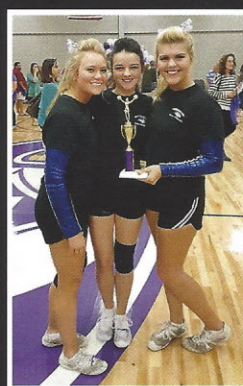
