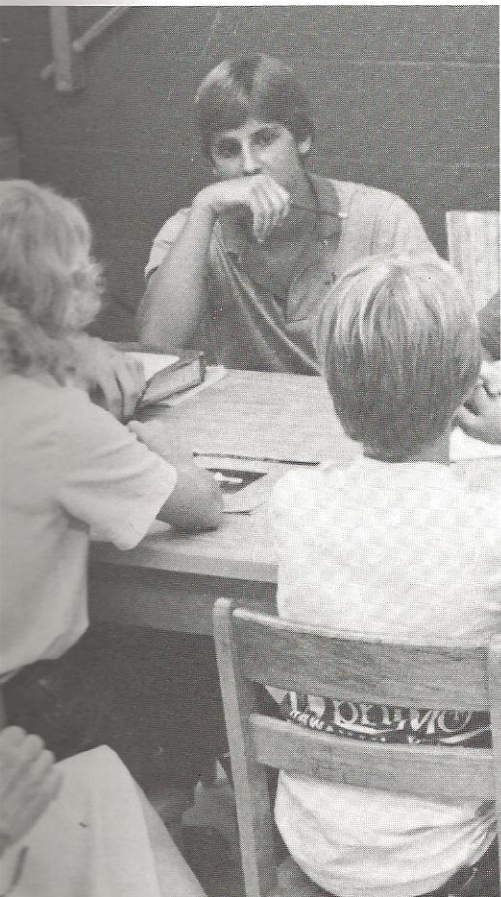


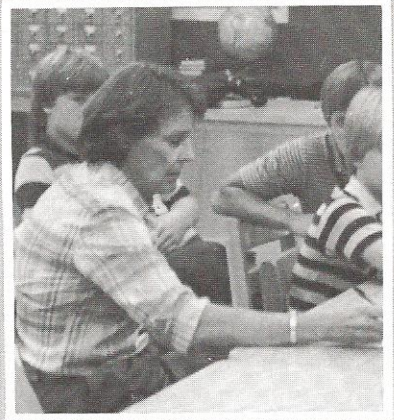
# Student Council Benefits School
