A Perfect 6-0

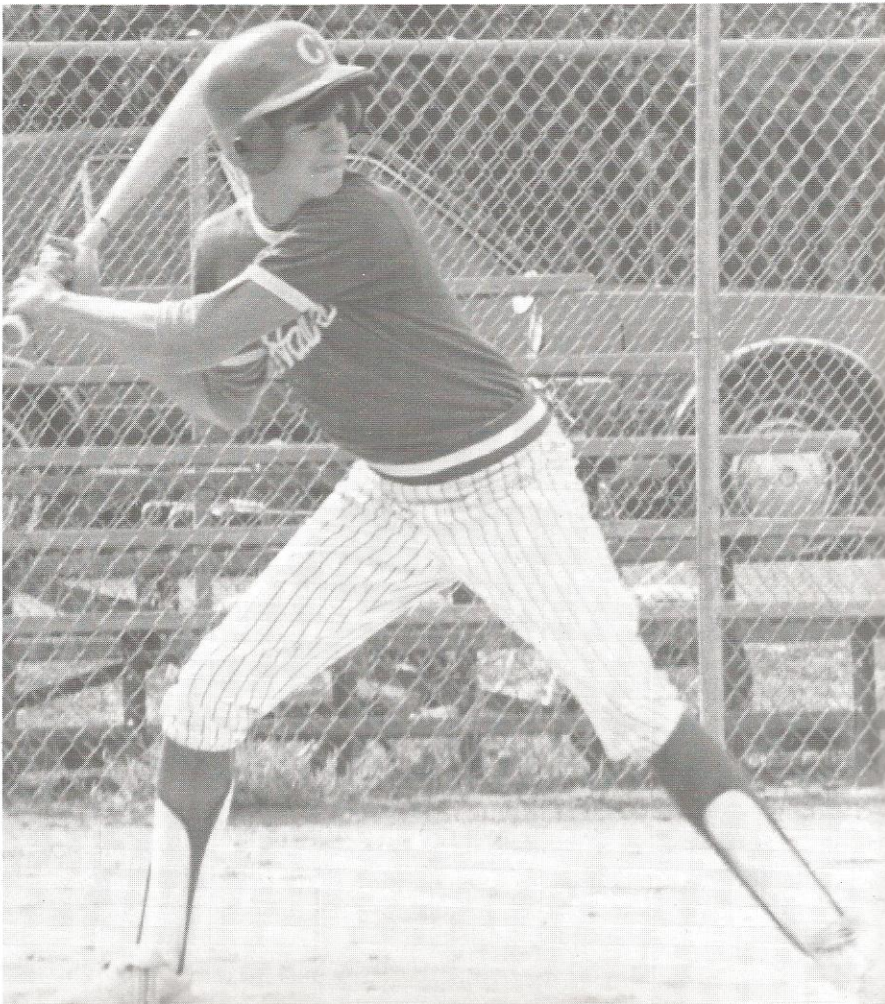
