**MOST CONSCIENTIOUS**

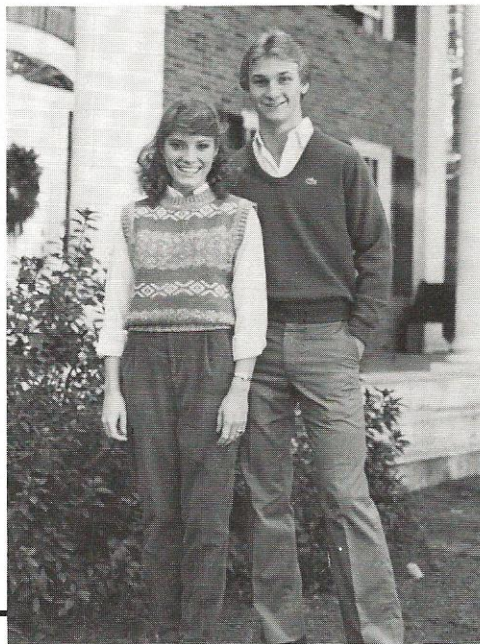
