Amy Goehring served as head photographer for the second year in a row. She gave up many afternoons and shed many tears over



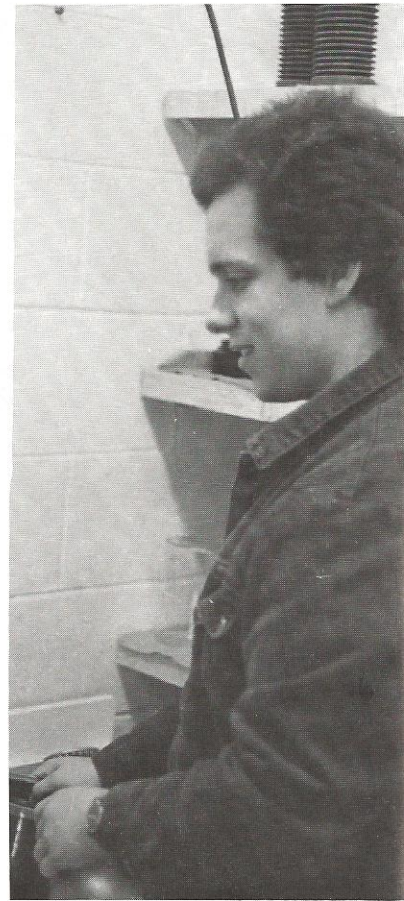
