

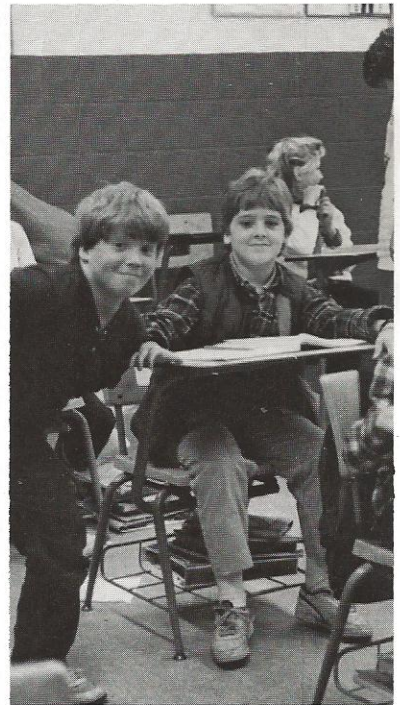
A Sixth Grader's Viewpoint
