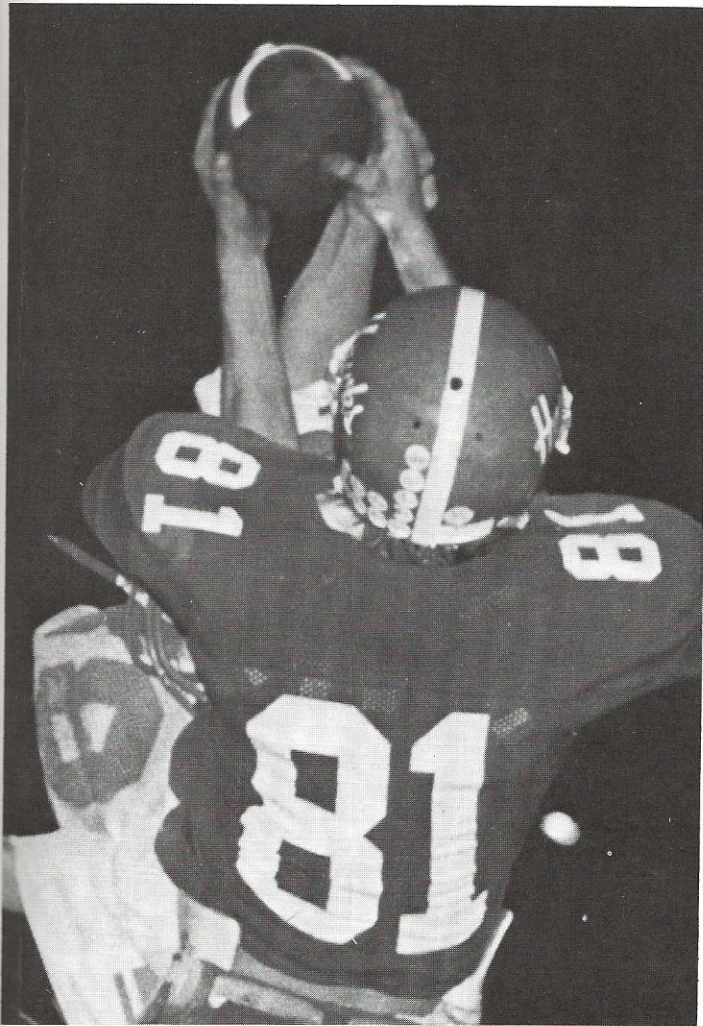


AN UP AND DOWN SEASON

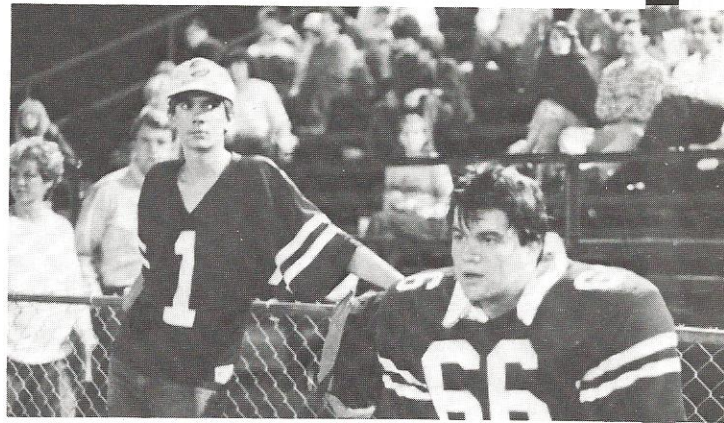


The varsity football team had a season filled with excitement and sorrow. They came close in many games, but they only won two.
