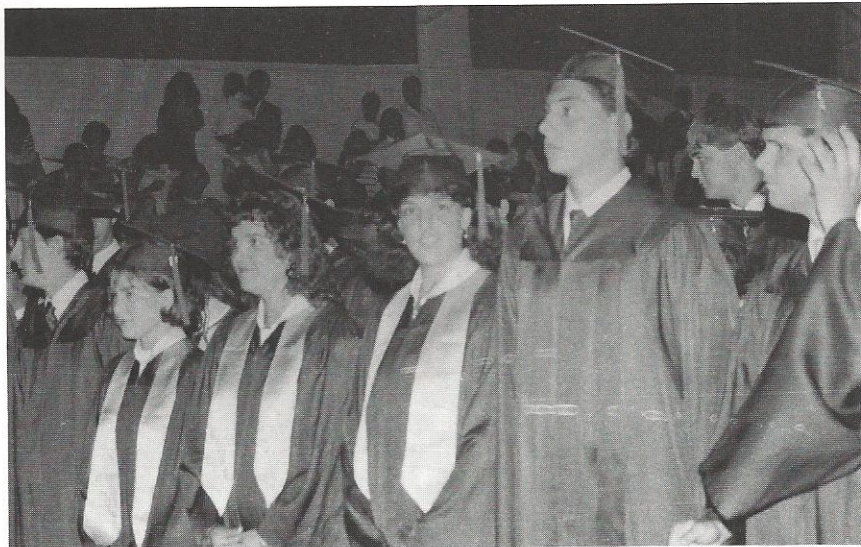


A TIME OF TEARS
