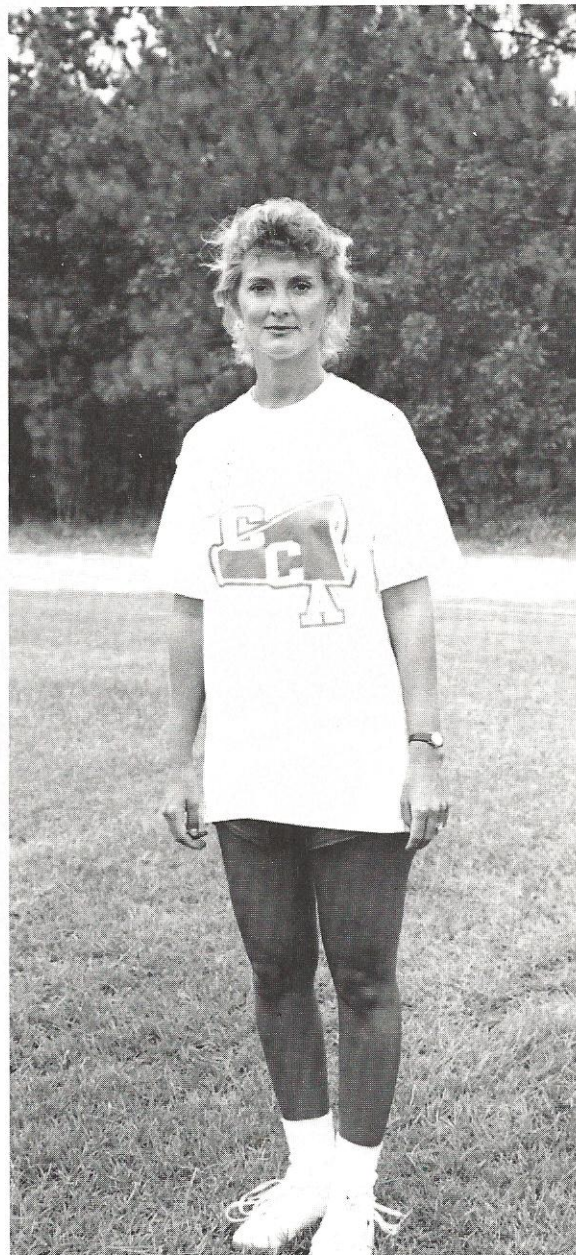


Unity:
