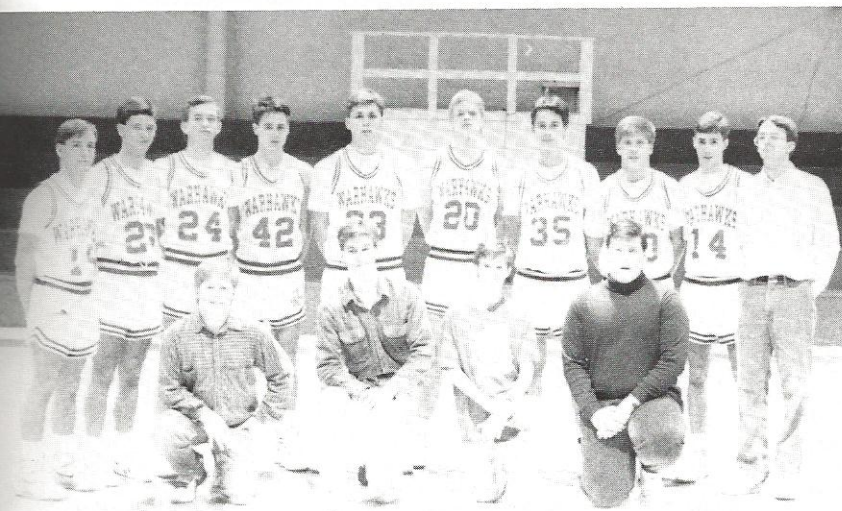


# Experience:
