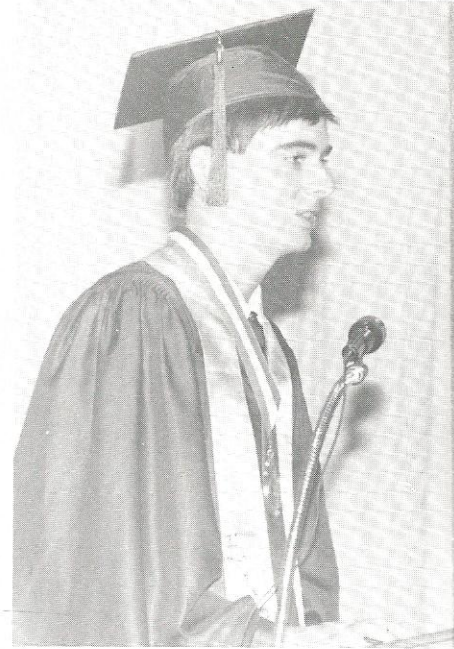

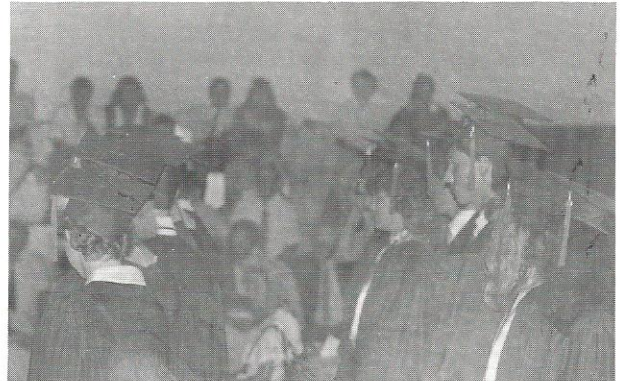


Valedictorian Kevin Beach speaks of the past and of what the future may hold for the Class of '89.
