

● In September, Apple released its two newest iPhone models, the 5s and the 5c. The 5s is very similar to previous models, while the 5c has a plastic back that comes in a variety of colors and also has a cheaper price tag than the traditional iPhone models.

● Researchers found the closest thing to an Earth-twin in size and composition, though it's far too hot to support life as we know it. Kepler-78b is just 20 percent larger and about 69 percent more massive than our planet, with a density nearly identical to

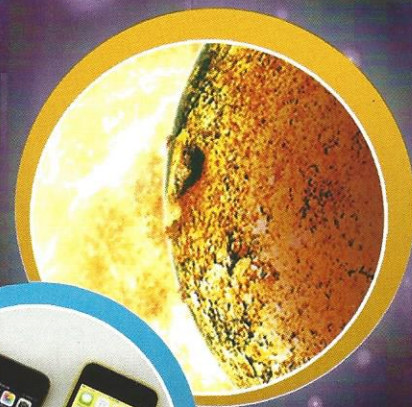
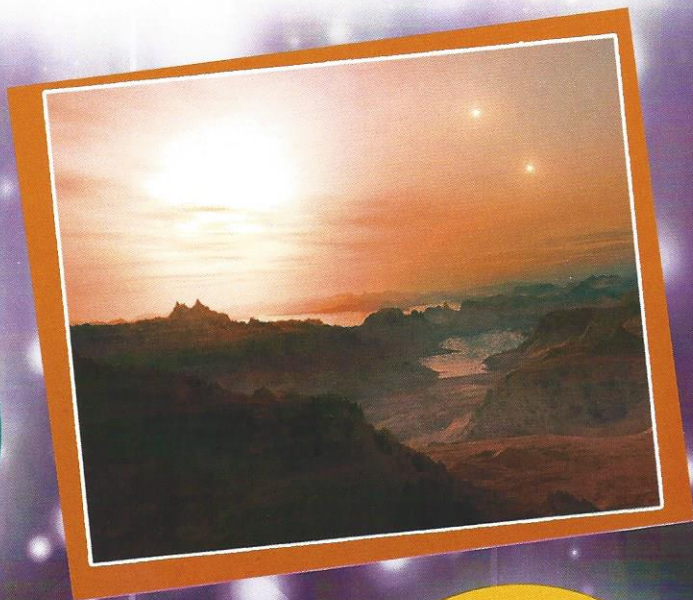
that of Earth. The planet is about 400 light-years from Earth, lies just 900,000 kilometers from its host star and completes one orbit every 8.5 hours. Surface temperatures on Kepler-78b likely top 3,680 degrees Fahrenheit.

● Astronomers discovered a solar system packed with planets, three of which are habitable – meaning in the zone around the star where liquid water could exist, making them possible candidates for the presence of life. The Gliese 667C star is orbited by between five and seven planets and is part

of a triple-star system known as Gliese 667.

● Microsoft announced the release of their new gaming console, Xbox One, in several countries across the world on November 22nd. The highly-anticipated console comes with the upgraded motion-sensing Kinect to optimize the gaming experience.

● Sony announced the release of their new gaming console, PlayStation 4, in the United States and Canada on November 15th.
