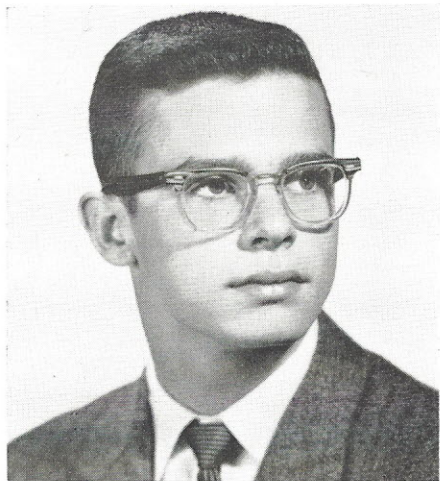


# The Student Council — Spring
