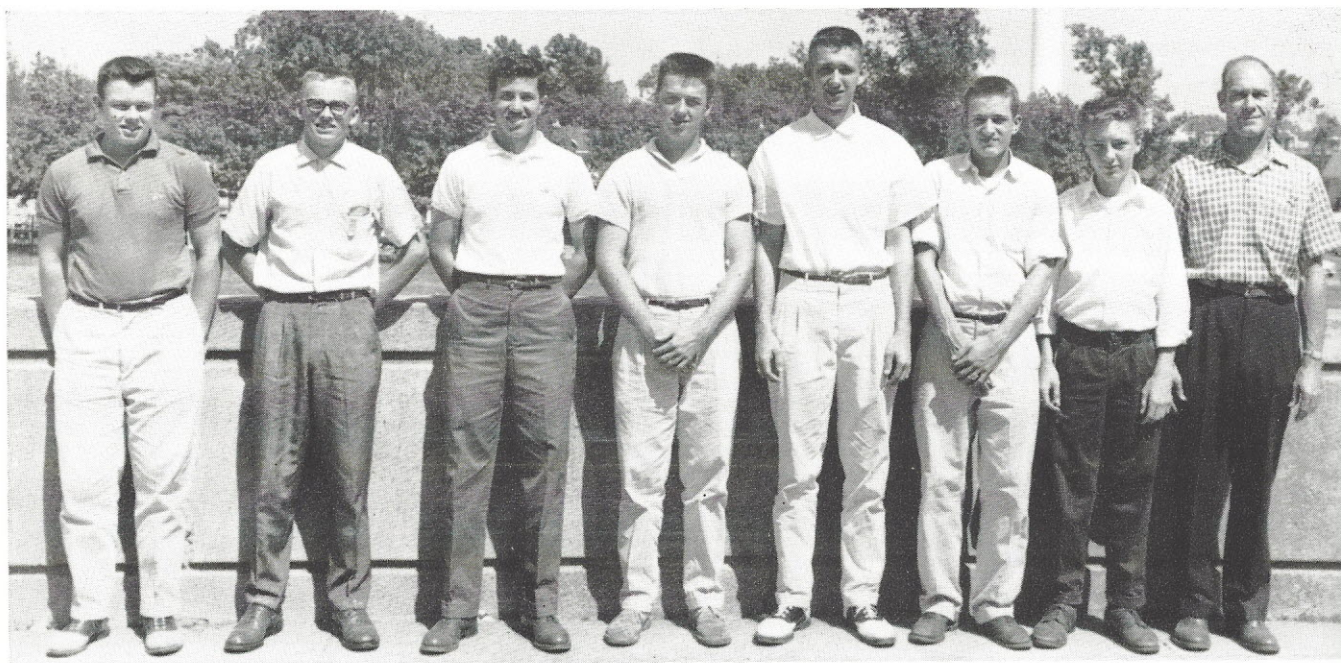


Golf Team
