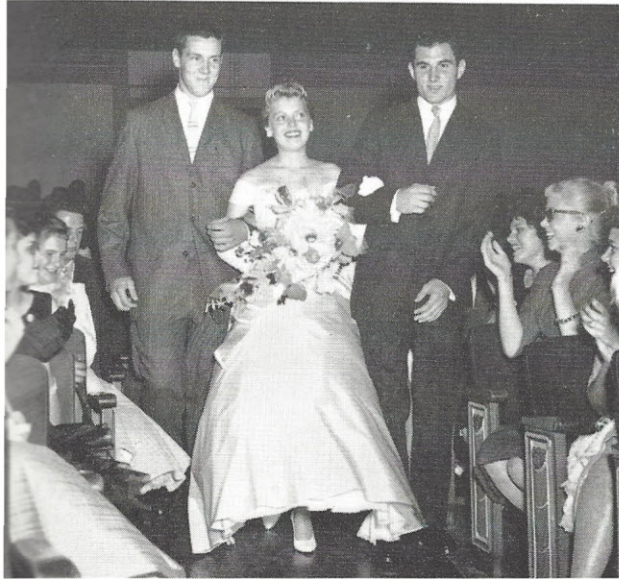


Miss Southwest Dance and Presentation
