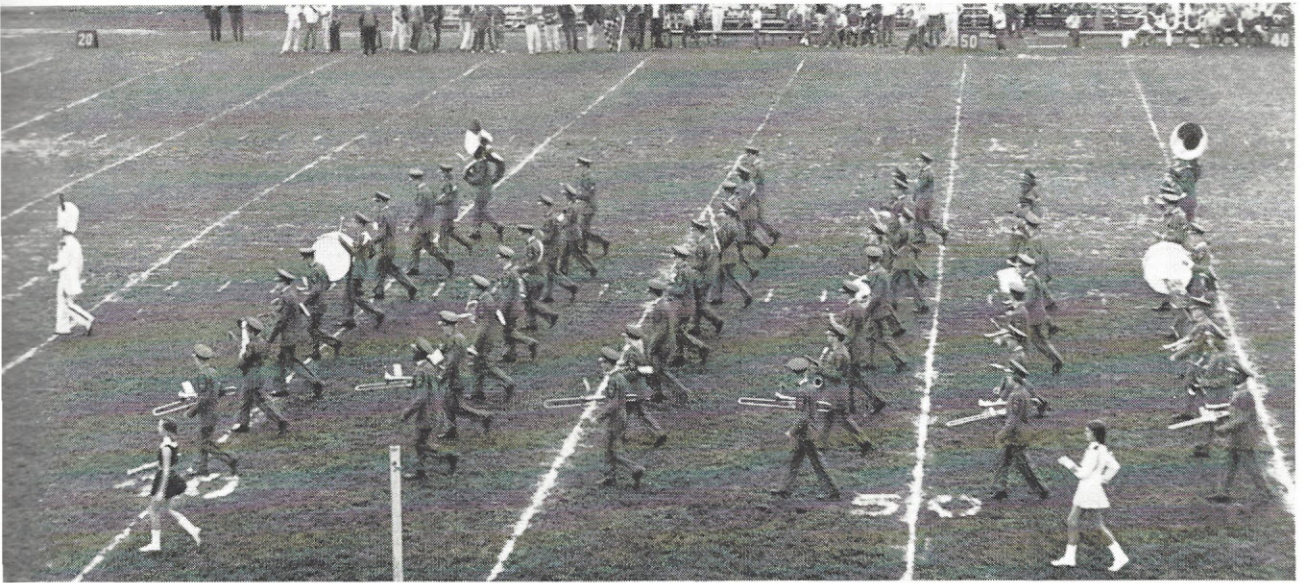


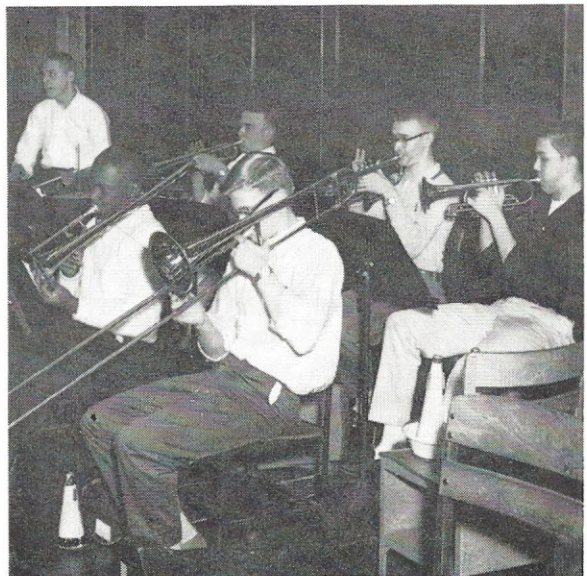
Statesman Show Band
