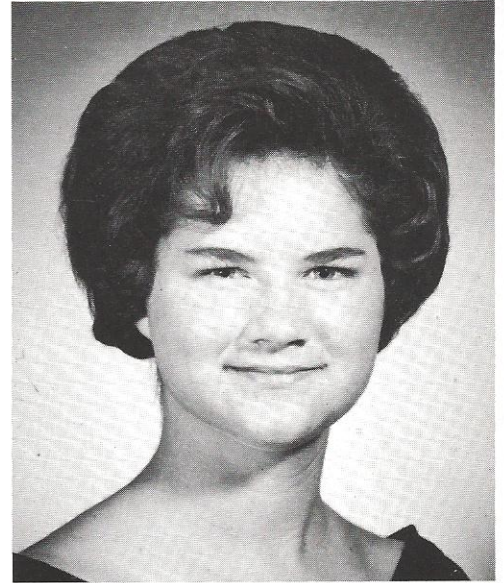

National Merit Finalists

The National Merit Tests are given each year to conduct a nation-wide search for high school students possessing unusual promise of intellectual achievement and to encourage these students to attend college by awarding scholarships to as many as possible.

Students who make high marks on the qualifying test given in March of the junior year, on the College Entrance Examination Board in December of their senior year, and on their school grades are selected as Finalists. National Merit Scholars are then chosen according to ability and financial need.

This year seven people from Walterboro were chosen for All-State Chorus. These people were chosen by Mr. Senn, at Bamville, S. C., on October 5, 1963. On February 21, 1964, they went to the Furman University Auditorium for the All-State Chorus
