






Reflections of Summer Become Realities of Fall

Along with memories.











Vocational School


Bulldogs Suffered Defeats-but Scores Don't Tell It All







Ends Basketball Season




Girls Basketball Team







Speed-The Key Factor for Track


Busy Year for W.H.S. Band
