Sharing The Special Moments

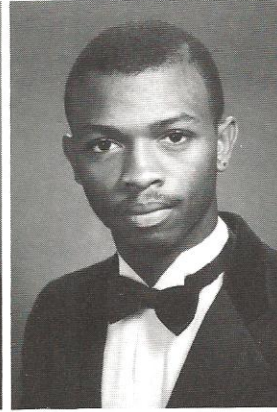
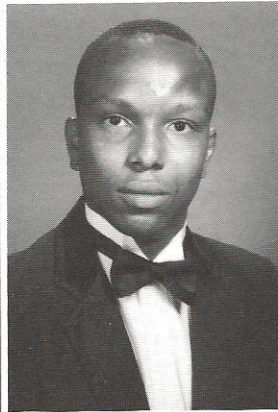
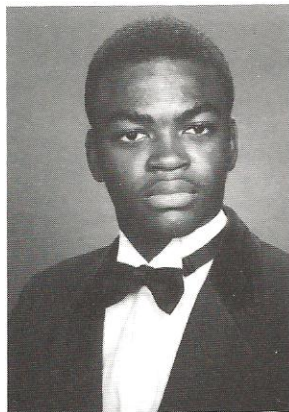
