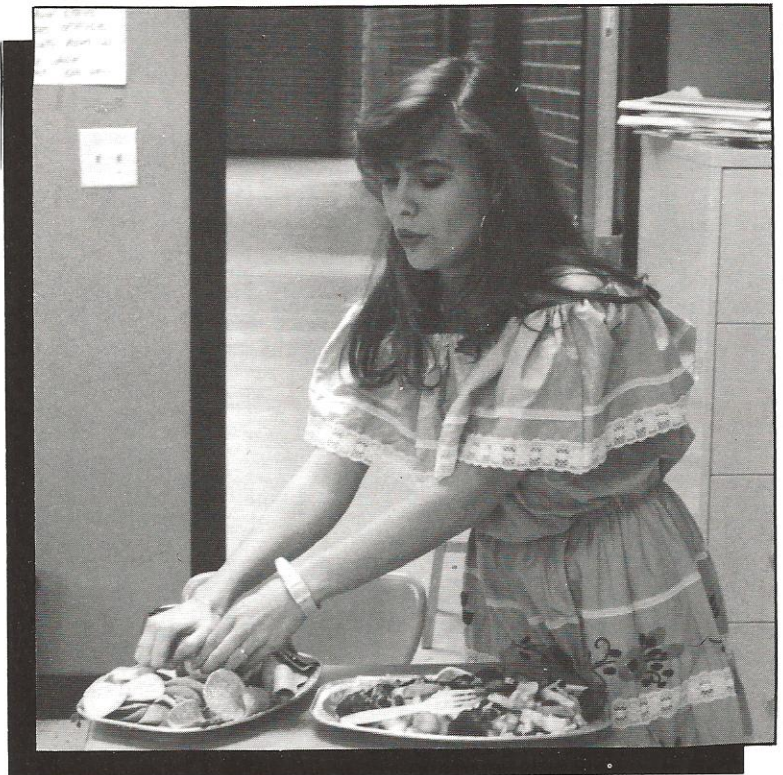


Ingles or English?
