

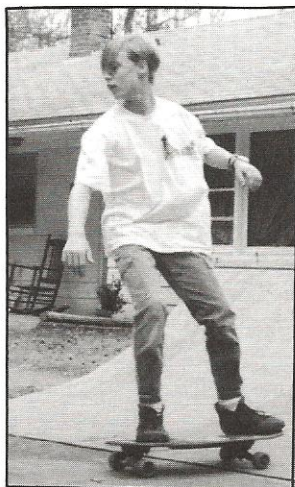
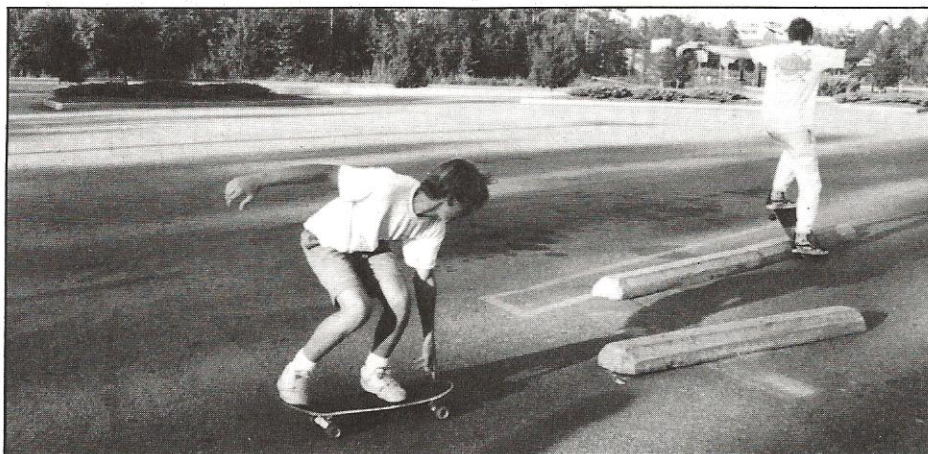


Sophomore Jamie Iriel does an impressive invert, a more advanced move, while wearing a popular "O'neill" slogan shirt.
