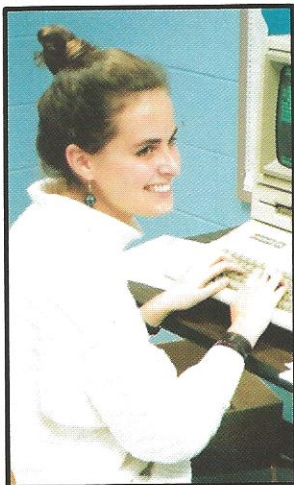


## What Do You Think?

*Q: What kind of statement do you want to make when you dress?*

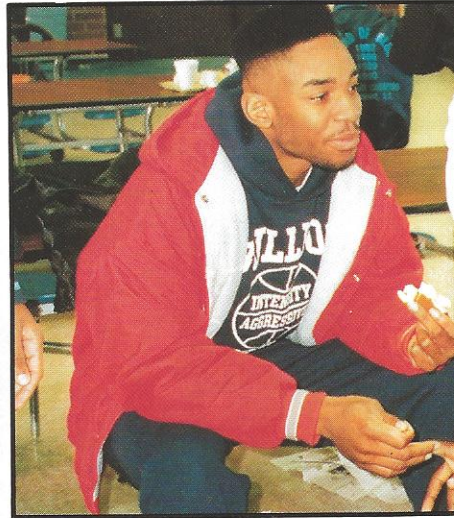
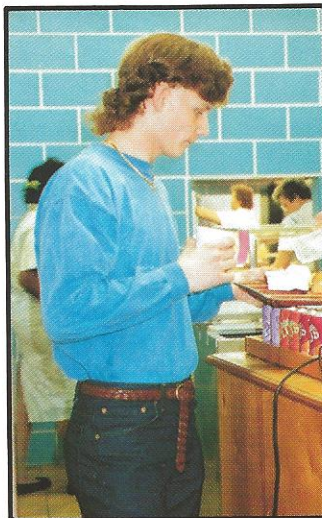
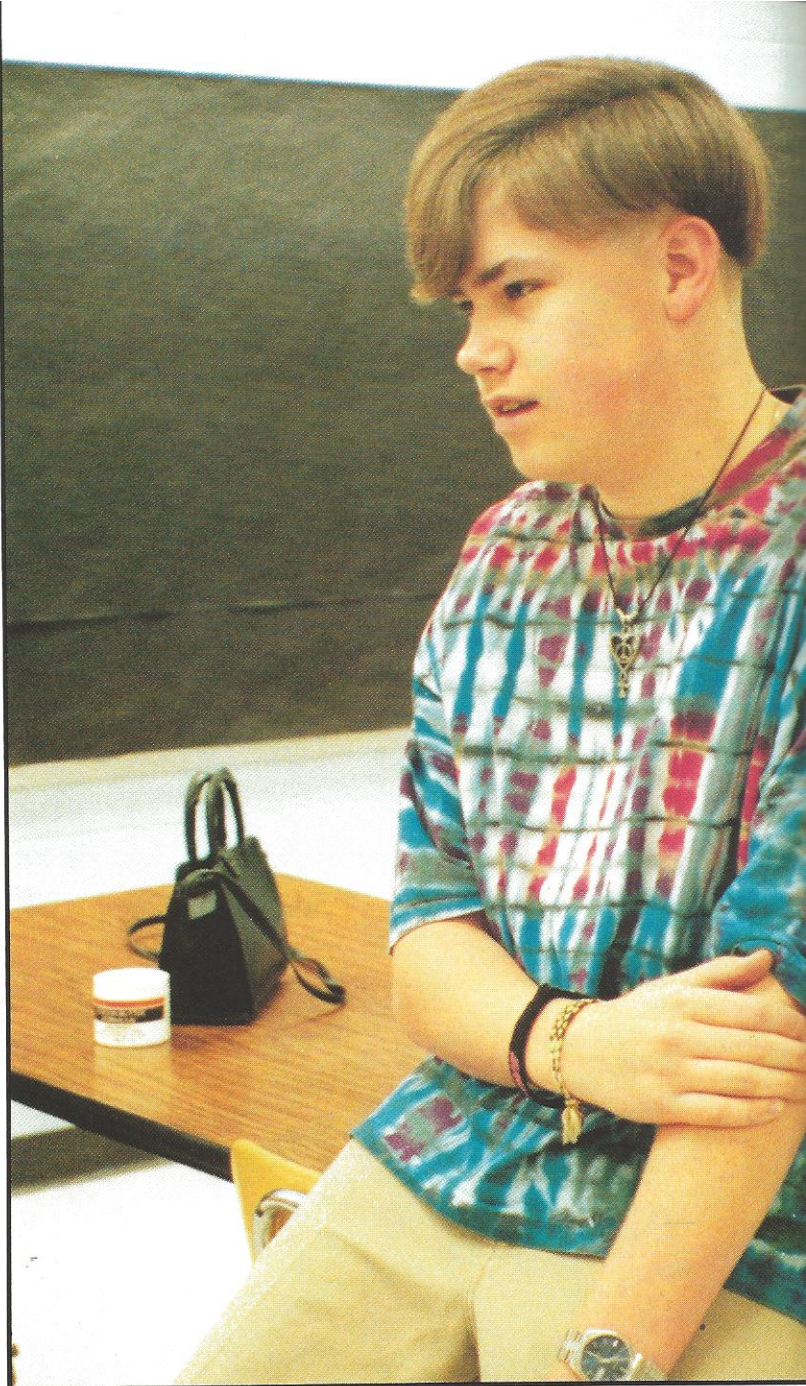
“The look I try to strive for is an original one,” said senior Hallie Gregory. “If I stand out in a positive way, then I am happy.”
