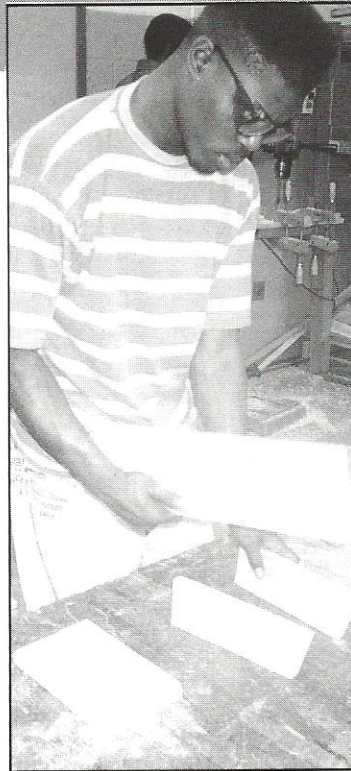
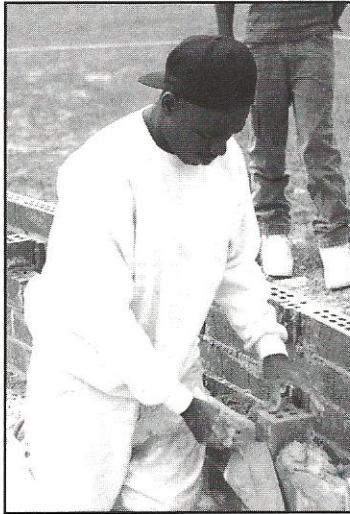
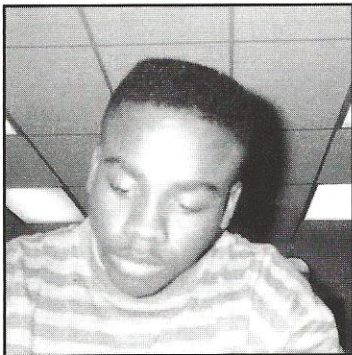


Anthony Murdaugh builds a bird house. Ruffin High students also attended the Vocational School.

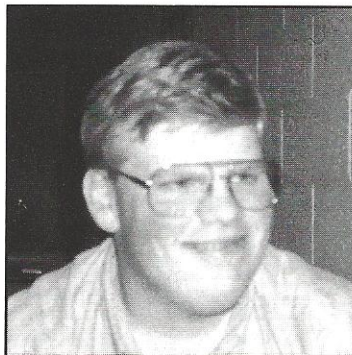

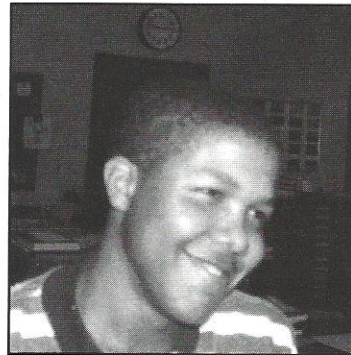
Senior Telly Lewis trowels the mortar between the bricks for the seating project. This was Telly's second year at the Vocational School.
