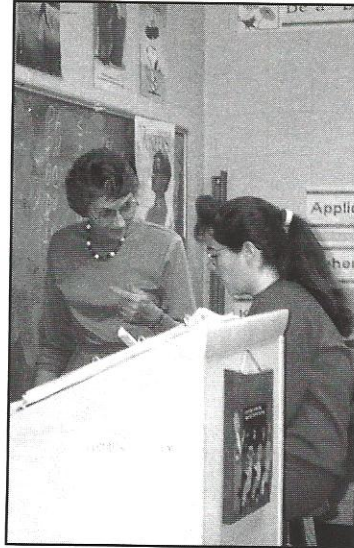
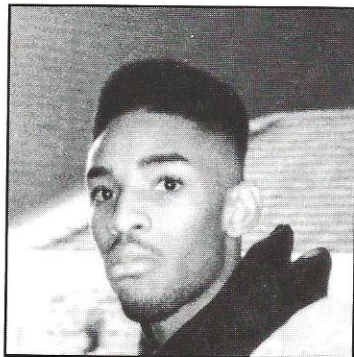
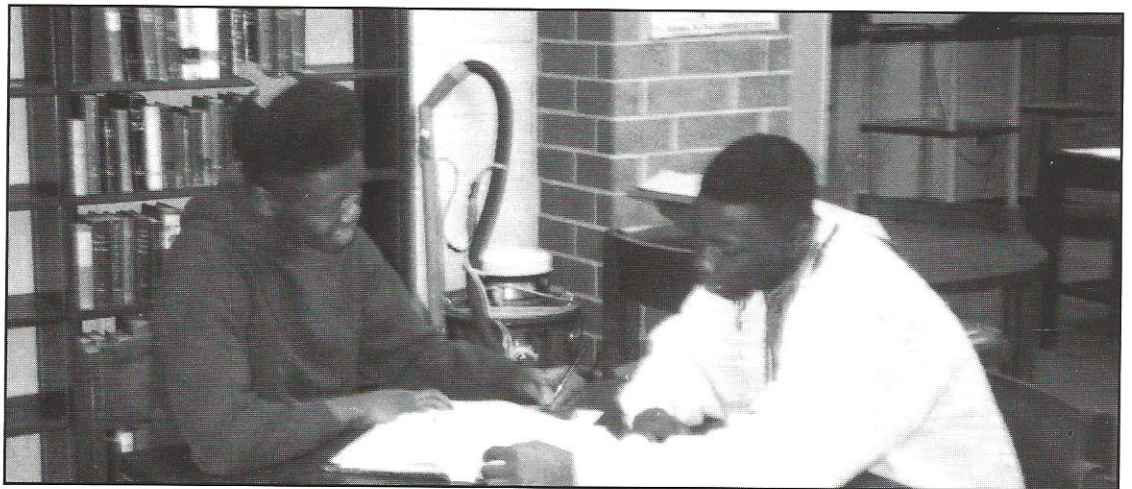


Senior Maurice Flournoy works diligently to finish up the last problem. Students could always be found outside classroom doors making up work missed the previous day.

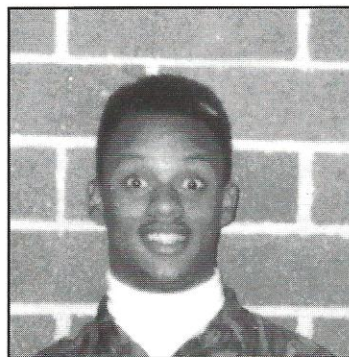


Mrs. Blocker could always be found lending a helping hand to students. Tracy Crosby made use of this hand as she absorbed everything said to her during their chats.
