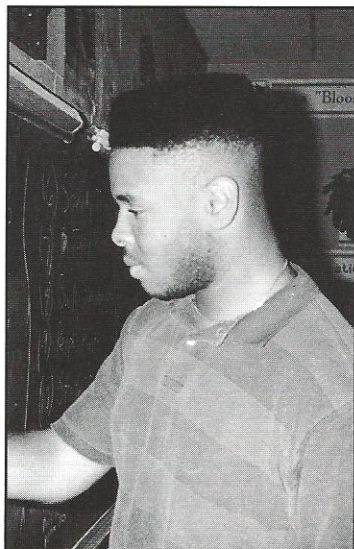
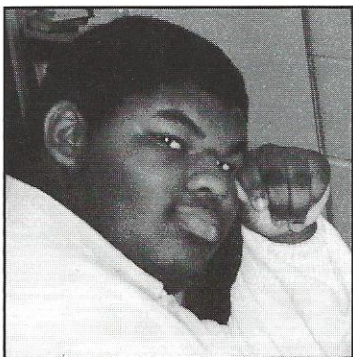


Captain Marvin Tucker looks over the agenda to see who their competitors would be at that competition. The A-Team placed tenth out of the forty schools that competed.



Wilmar Stephens explains an equation during practice. The A-Team holds practice on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

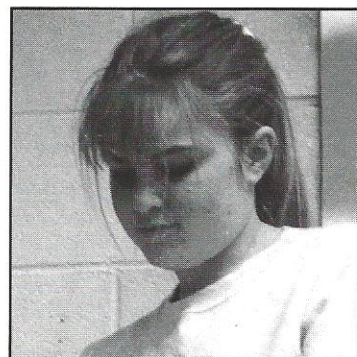
Observing the team's progress during the Knowledge Master is coach Janis Blocker. This is like any other competition in that it can only be played on a computer.
