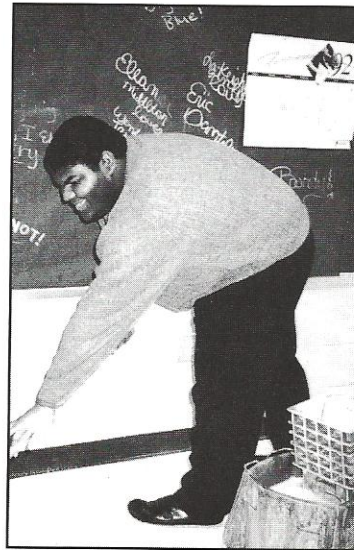
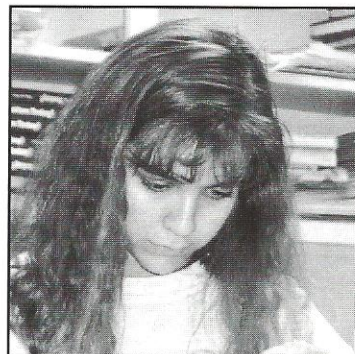
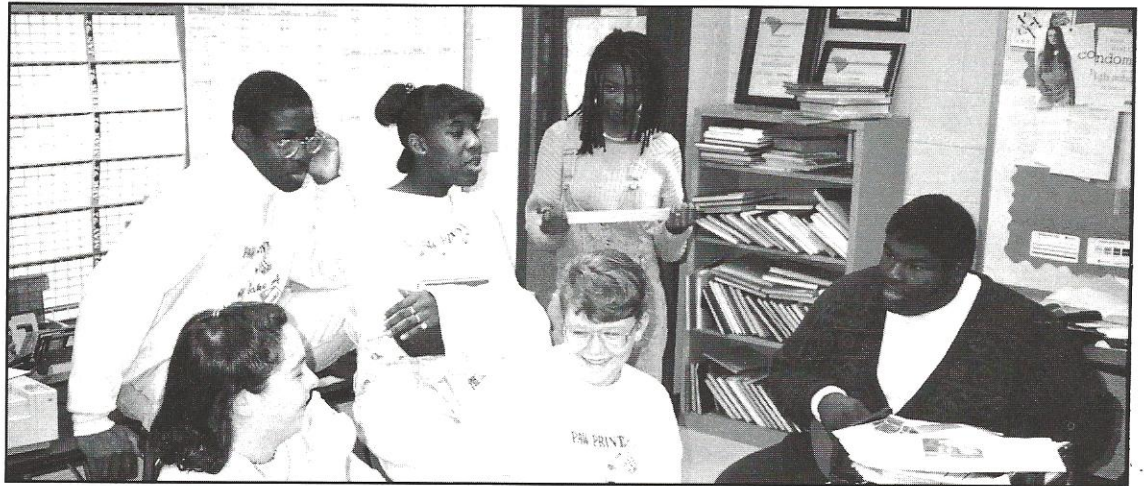


Looking through a recent annual is advisor Mrs. Marilyn Zielke. This is Mrs. Zielke's tenth year as yearbook advisor.

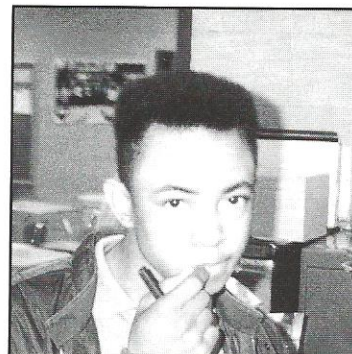


Newspaper editor Marvin Tucker mops the floor to show what would happen to staffers who did not sign out. Staff members were required to sign out when going on assignments.

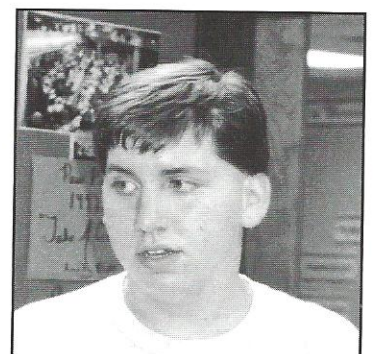
