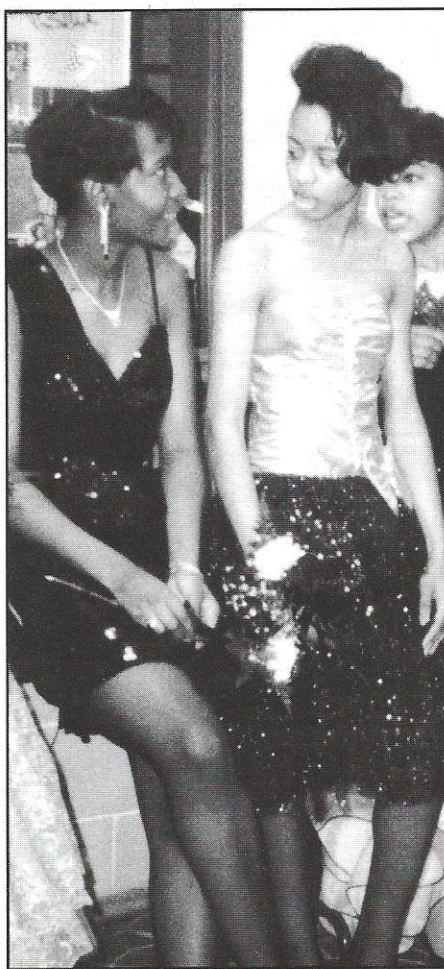
Many juniors also got their class rings. This also, was a long awaited event. "I really like my class ring; it gives me a feeling of belonging to the school," said Charlie Sullivan.
