

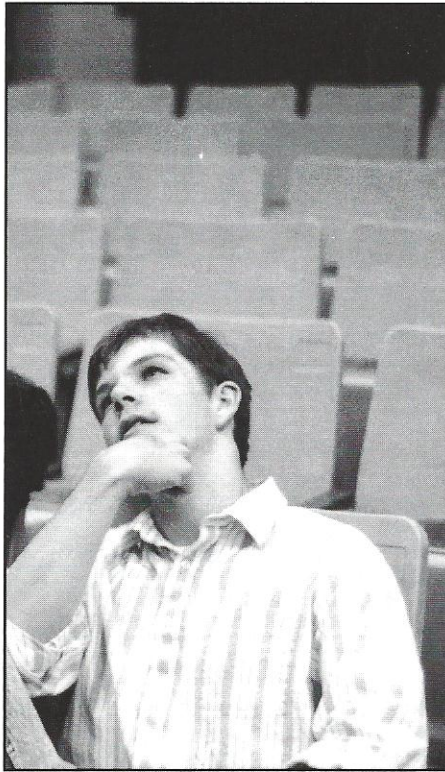
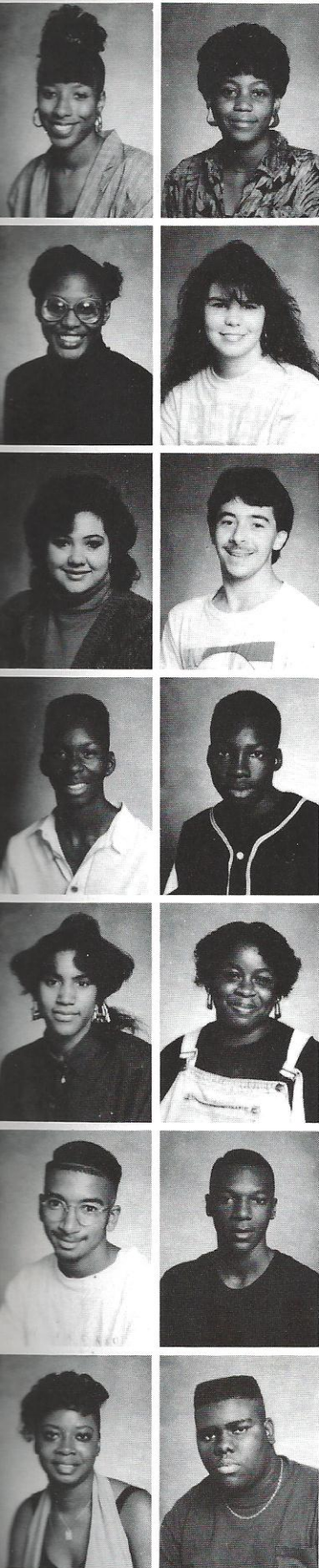
Under Pressure
