

Tears of Joy

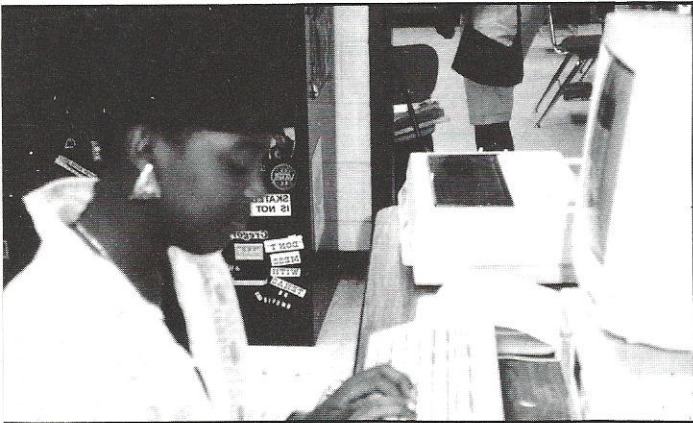
When Sherrice Lisbon was announced Miss Junior on the night of March 19, she began crying. "I was both happy and surprised to be announced winner," said Sherrice.
