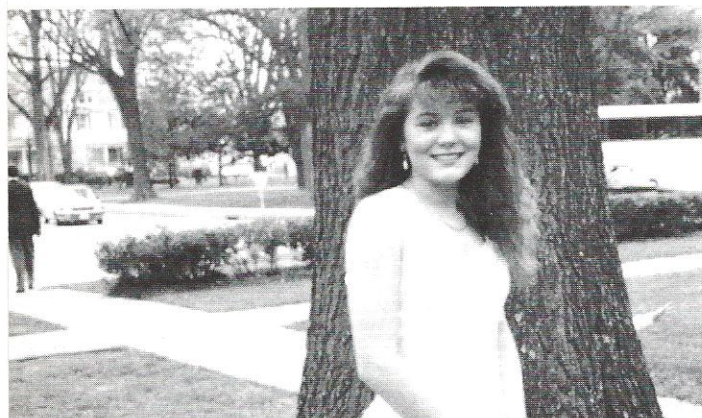
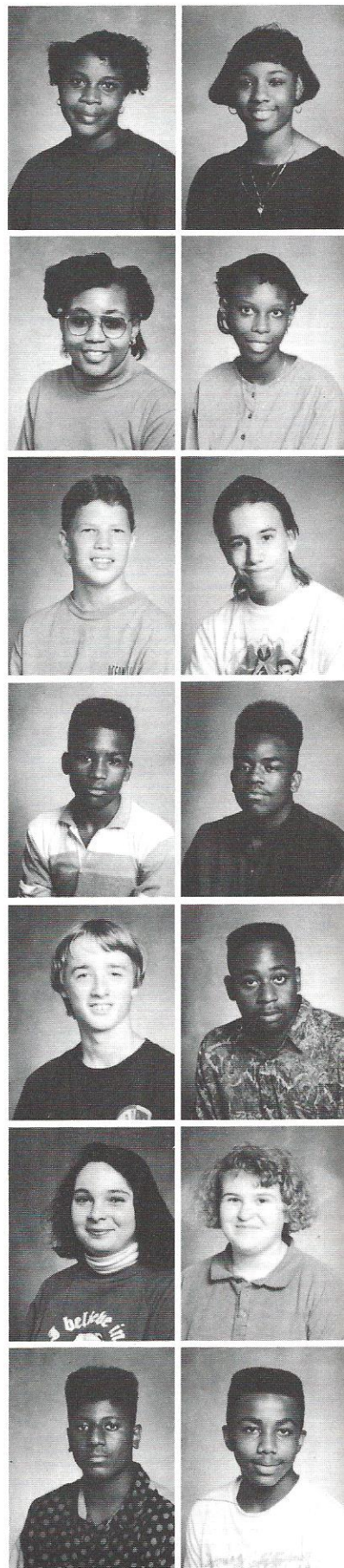
Lindsey said that although she was a little nervous at first, she felt she had a good chance of winning because of her previous pageant experience.
