Soccer — Chris Turner, offensive leader; Jeb Huckabee, defensive leader.

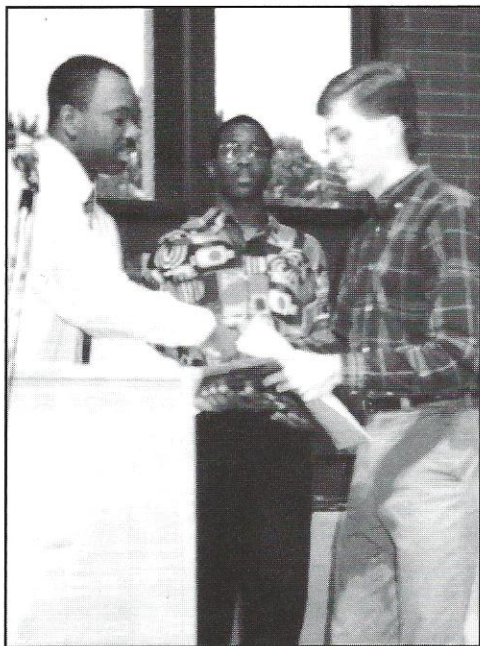
Softball — Diane Lisbon, offensive leadership; Missy Bennett, defensive leadership.
