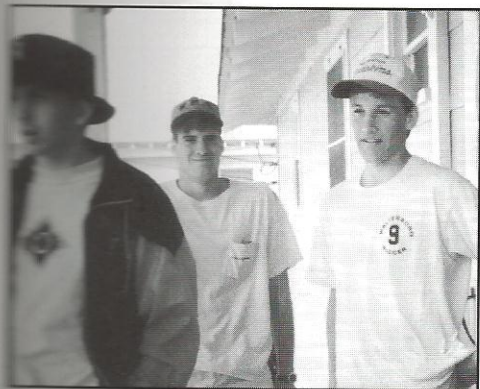

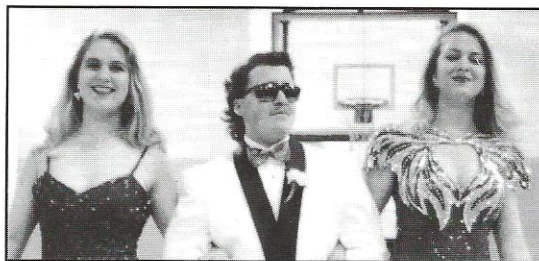
Spring Break ran from Friday, April 2 until Monday, April 12. Students spent this free time visiting relatives, working for extra spending money, or simply just lying out at the beach.
