One goal was to make all of the senior events a success.

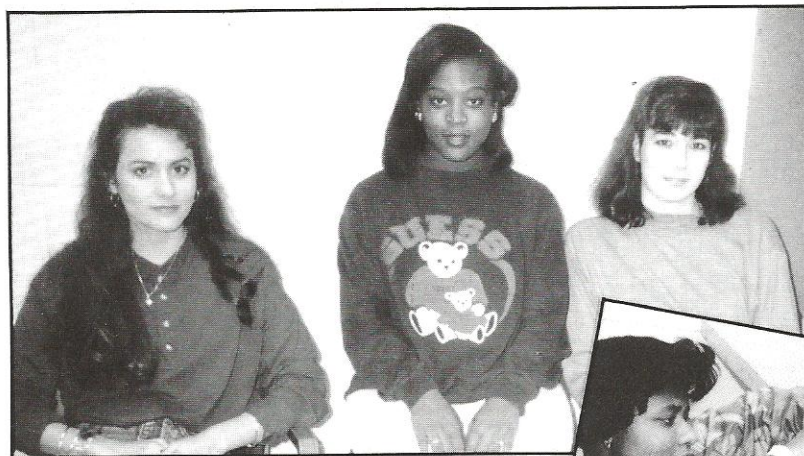
"I plan to make the senior class trip to Disney World a success and to make graduation a success," said Vice President Gail Rearden.
