

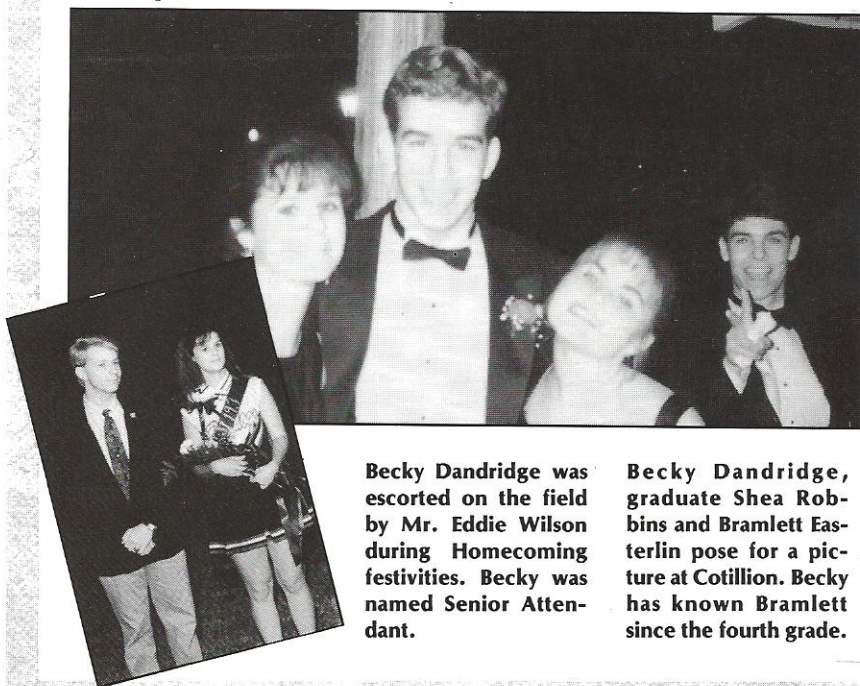
Surprise!
