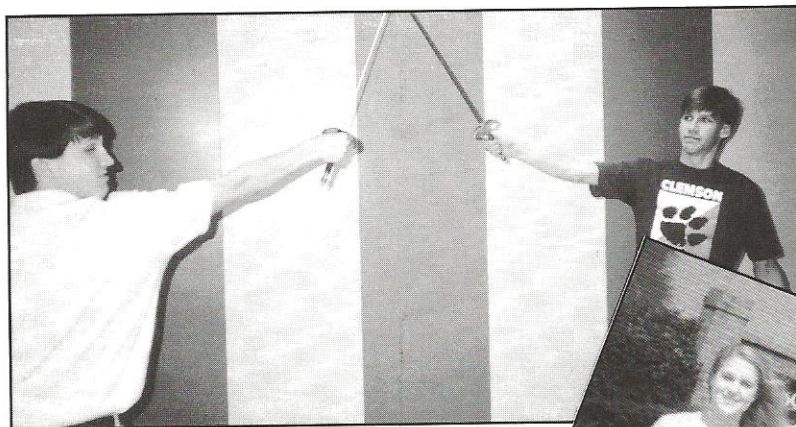
Amy Garrett has gone to the Governor's School for the Arts. She was one of a select few who attended the Governor's School whose work is on tour throughout the state.
