This was a great honor since most All-Region players are seniors.

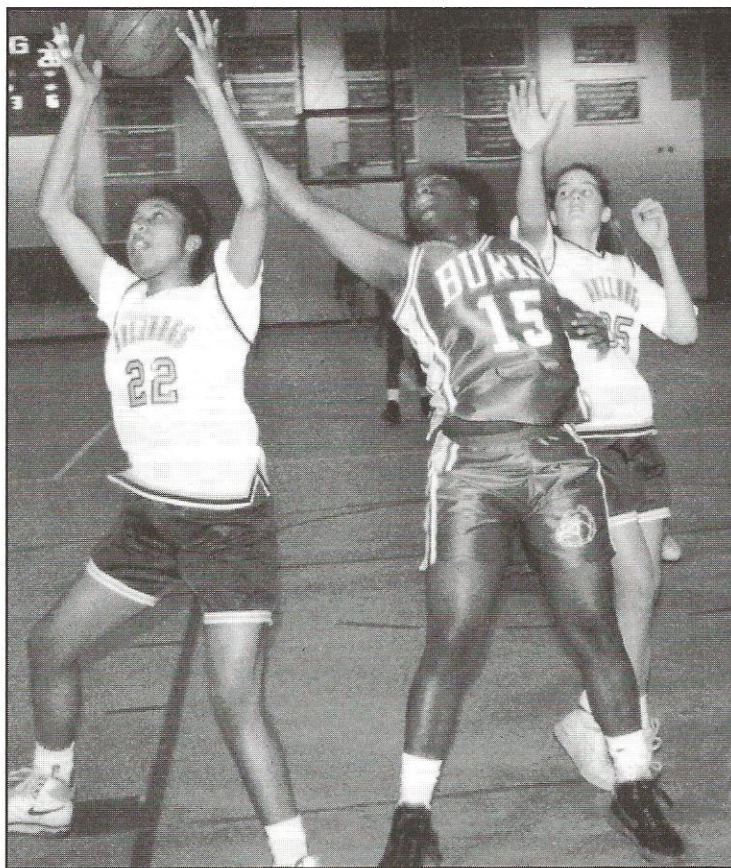
