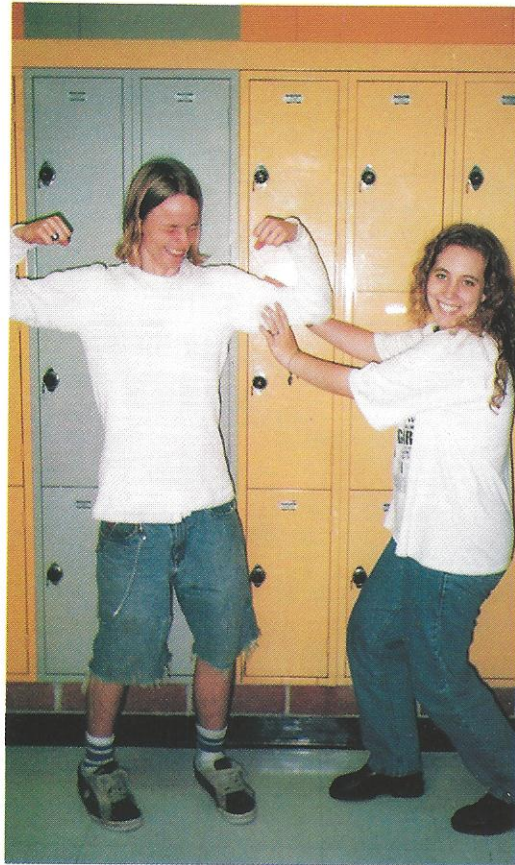
"My carefree personality and different tastes make me unique," said Marlo. Marlo was glad that he was chosen because it was something people think of him as.
