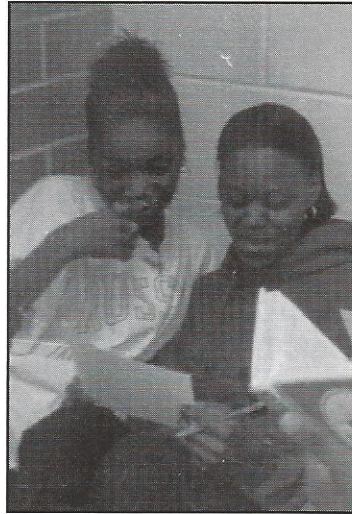
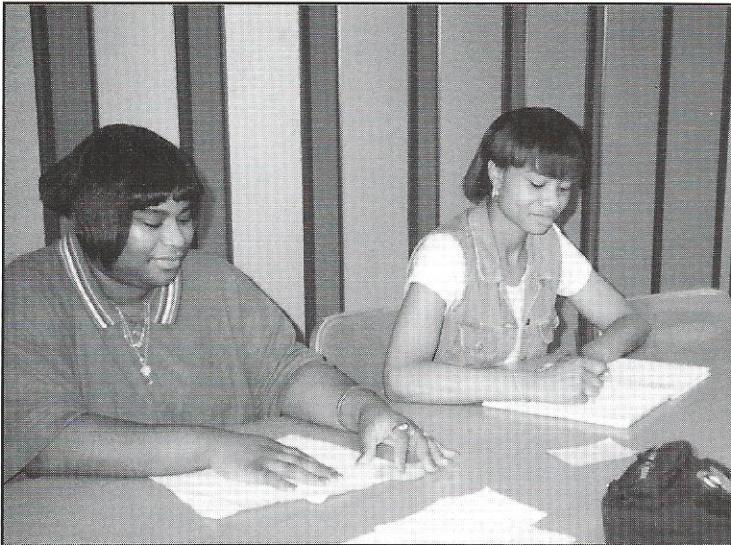


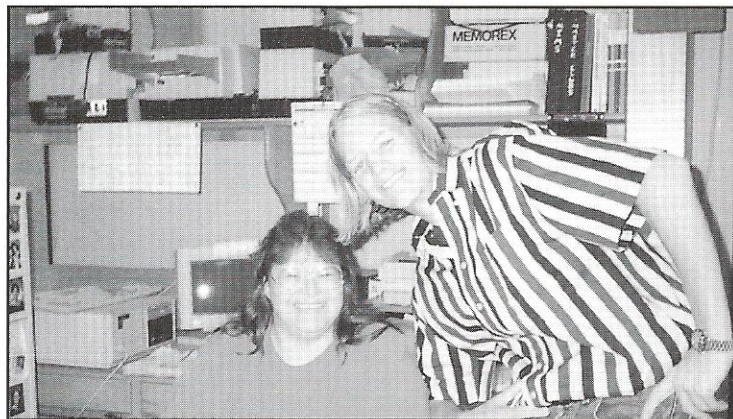
Students crowd the guidance offices trying to correct their new schedules. Many of them found that fixing their schedules required long waiting.



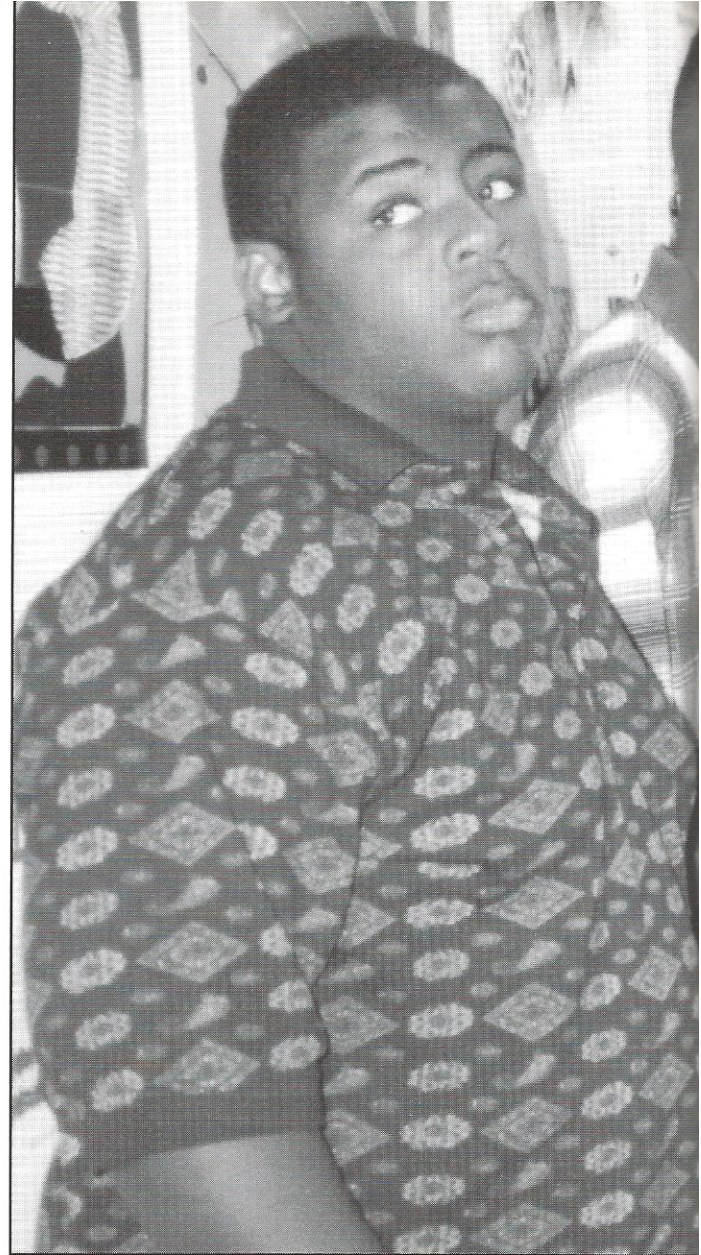
