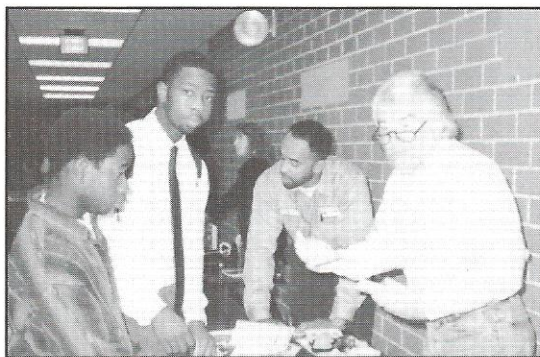


It's All Right
