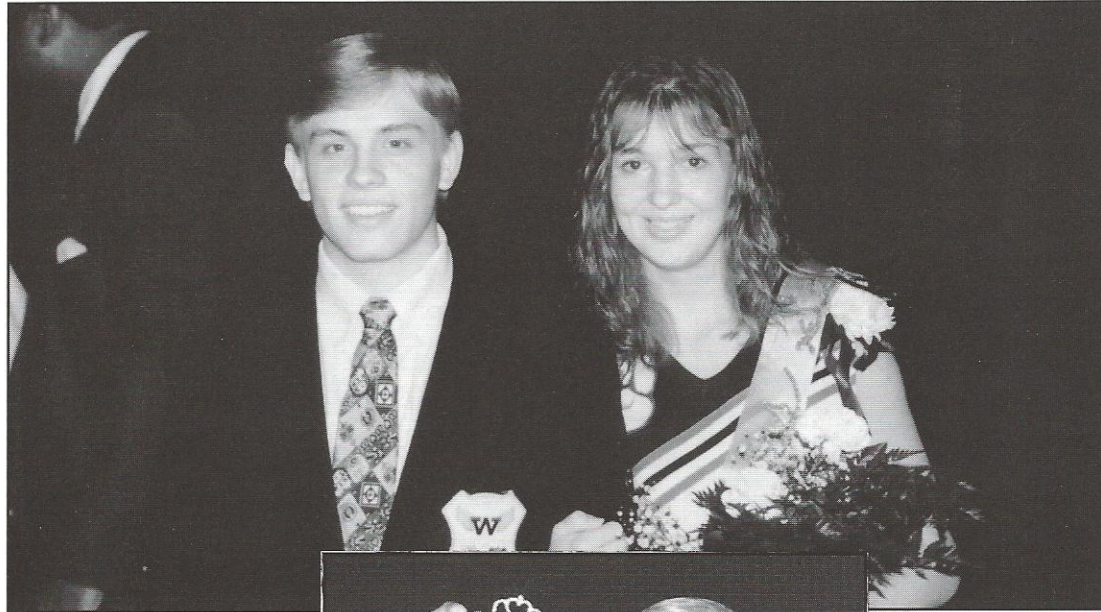
"I thought I was going to lose," said Akima. "Words cannot describe how I feel!"
