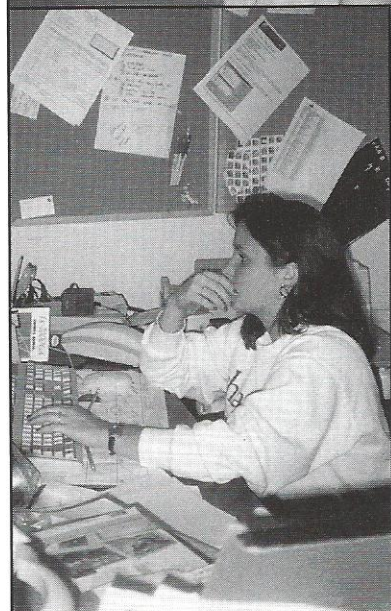


Nights At Home
